

*The only instances where a student should retake a Performance Series assessment is if the Auto-Spoil feature is triggered or to be in compliance with the student's IEP. If the Performance Series test engine determines that a student is answering too quickly or in patterned sequences, it triggers the Auto-Spoil feature. If a student triggers Performance Series' Auto-Spoil feature, the student will need to start the assessment over to get a valid score. If a teacher determines that the Performance Series test was not given at the student's appropriate grade level as designated in the IEP, then the teacher can ask for the test to be spoiled, have the student's starting grade-level set at the appropriate level, and then re-administer the assessment.*
