

USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES BY SCHOOL RELATED ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education of the School District recognizes the need for certain types of meetings and activities which are related to the organized educational program but which cannot be held during the regular school day. There are certain organizations and activities in the respective attendance areas which are nonsectarian, nonpolitical, nonprofit, membership unrestricted, and which complement and support the organized educational program of the public schools. The Board is desirous of giving encouragement to the work of such organizations. In certain instances, the school building provides the only available and most suitable meeting place for such organizations and activities. It shall be the policy of the Board to make school buildings available for meetings of such organizations in accordance with approved administrative rules and regulations.
