Our Busy Tree	The tall cherry tree in this book is an important habitat for many animals – for a home, for food, for hiding, and so on.	<b>C</b>

Wet Walk	Rosita gets wet when she slips in a puddle walking in the rain.	<b>D</b>
Fall Is Fun	Fall is one of the four seasons of the year. Children can entertain themselves during the fall, especially when the leaves change color and fall.	<b>C</b>
Under the Night Sky	While camping with his family each summer, a young boy especially loves nighttime when he can gaze at the MOON and the stars. He watches and dreams each night as the moon seems to change positions.	<b>D</b>
